SUBJECT: Full Day Elementary Care as Needed for 2019-2020

When the Methacton elementary schools are closed and Kids in the Village Early Learning Center is open, we offer all day care for students enrolled in our Before and After School Care program and for families who have registered for care on an As Needed basis.

Donna Ceschan, Kids in the Village's Office Manager, will post a sign-up sheet for the Kindergarten and Before and After Care families so they can indicate what days their children will need all day care. Families that have registered for care on an As Needed basis must contact Donna directly to reserve care.

The rate for all day care for the 2019-2020 school year is \$92.00 a day for As Needed students. The rate for all day care for Kindergarten and Before and After Elementary Care students will be prorated according to this formula: $\$92.00 - (\text{your child's weekly rate} \div 5)$ and covers up to ten hours of care between the hours of 6:45am and 5:45pm.

All day care will be available at Kids in the Village Early Learning Center when the Methacton Elementary schools are closed on the following dates:

September	30
October	9, 14
November	5, 26, 27*
December	23, 26, 27, 30, 31*
February	14, 18
March	13, 27
April	8, 9, 13, 28
May	22

The highlighted areas are when Kindergarten is closed and we offer care.

*Kids in the Village Early Learning Center will close at 4pm on November 27th & December 31st.

In the event that MSD is closed due to inclement weather and KITV is not, no care will be provided to the elementary students except normal scheduled hours. In the event of a delayed opening at MSD, before-care will be provided. In the event Methacton has an early dismissal, there will be no after-care.
